- At the end of Sec 1, Humanities subjects can be offered as a SBB subject

Some Pointers:

- SBB is for lower secondary only.
- Students may continue to do the subject at a more demanding level at Upper Secondary if they meet the criteria set by the school

Full SBB School

- There is social mix in the classes. Each class consists of about 22/23 students from the Express course,
 9/10 from NA course and 4/5 from NT course.
- Common Curriculum: CCE, PE, Music, Art, Design & Technology, Food Consumer Education – the boys will attend the lessons as a class
- Other Subjects: The boys will attend the lessons by teaching groups.

Our Approach to SBB

- Attend lesson together for the more demanding subject
- Marks for more demanding subjects will be converted accordingly to take into account the higher standards and rigour

Coping with SBB

- Bridging support will be provided where necessary
- Consultations students have opportunities to consult teachers after school
- Emotional support Teachers will help students manage stress and peer relations
