1. KEY EVENTS IN TERM 3

1.1 Youth Day Holiday (1 Jul, Mon)

Youth Day falls on 30 June, Sun and Mon, 1 July will be a school holiday. Lessons will resume on 2 July, Tue.

1.2 86th Prefects Commendation (2 Jul, Tue)

The Prefects Commendation Service on 2 July, Tue, will witness the commendation of Secondary 3 Senior Prefects assuming the leadership of the 86th Prefectorial Board for 2024-2025 as well as the appointment of Secondary 2 Prefects.

1.3 National Day Holiday (9 Aug, Fri)

National Day on 9 August, Fri will be a public holiday. Lessons will resume on 12 August, Mon.

1.4 Early Dismissal for Sec 1, 2, 3, 4N(A) & 4N(T) due to National Examination (3 Jul, Wed)

In view of the GCE O-Level Mother Tongue Languages Listening Comprehension Examination in the afternoon, students from Secondary 1, 2, 3, 4N(A) and 4N(T) will be dismissed at 12.30 p.m. on 3 Jul, Wed.

1.5 Home-Based Learning Days for Sec 1 to 3 during National Oral Examinations (23 Jul, Tue to 25 Jul, Thu)

The GCE O-Level and N-Level Oral Examinations for graduating students will be conducted from 23 to 25 July 2024. All Secondary 1 to 3 students will attend home-based learning during the three days and will not be required to report to school.

- 2.2 Key steps for 'Reflecting and Improving':
 - a) Think about the situation you are in.
 - b) Identify your behaviour and feelings.
 - c) Consider if your behaviour is appropriate for the situation.
 - d) Identify other behaviours that would be helpful for the situation.

3. UPDATES ON VAPING MATTERS

3.1 Our school takes a firm stand against vaping and smoking, which are serious offences that warrant disciplinary actions, including suspension and/or caning for boys. We ask for your strong support in our enforcement of school rules that aim to develop our students' character and discipline and for their holistic well-being.

Material on the negative effects and consequences of vaping has been shared with all the students. We have attached the material for your reference so that you may have a serious discussion with your child/ward regarding vaping, which is illegal in Singapore.
